

Ensuring a Blind Peer Review

To ensure confidentiality in the peer review of the article sent to this journal, it is necessary to prevent authors from knowing the identity of reviewers and vice versa (double blind peer review). This involves authors, publishers and reviewers (who upload documents as part of their revision), who must adopt the necessary measures in the text and in the file's properties. On the one hand, the document's authors must remove their names from the text, using instead the mention "Author" and the year in the bibliography and in the footnotes, rather than the real author's name, the paper/book title, and so on. On the other hand, the author's identity must also be removed from the file's properties.
